Already at the end of last year, the airline with its Boeing fleet went live with AMOS. Since this year also the Embraer fleet is fully managed in AMOS. Much of the project success is due to Aeromexico's skilled and well organized team who attended to all details of this complex implementation project while always keeping an eye on the project milestones to be reached in time and within budget.
