Course Objectives

- ✓ Define alternates, requirements and special rules for rotables
- ✓ Create workorders with part request, attach links, references, etc
- ✓ Understand the meaning of the “*Maintenance Forecast*” as the main planning hub in AMOS.
- ✓ Assign different maintenance events to workpackages and issue workorders and pickslips in the workpackage.
- ✓ Set up and control any kind of check and report them back.
- ✓ Administer taskcards, transfer and close them, create findings
- ✓ Track all kind of maintenance events with different filter settings.
- ✓ Move workpackages on a time scale forward and backward in order to optimize the hangar utilization.
- ✓ Check workpackage planning at different stations in relation to the arrival and departure gates, available ground-time and manpower
