- Create and edit operator taskcards
- Create taskcards from existing tasks
- Edit work steps from existing tasks
- Pre-set a taskcard in Operator Maintenance Program
- Link a block taskcard to check in Maintenance Programs Administration
- Activate an Operator Maintenance Program
