Configuration Programs

- Define a new vendor in Address Administration
- Define properties, data and certificates
- Define conditions, warranties and codes
- Create a new consumable part and rotatable part in Part Administration
- Add purchasing and reordering info
- Add store location and measure units
- Copy info to an alternate and add remarks
- Use Price Book
- Set rating criteria in Active Supplier Rating and retrieve them across various programs
- Use Logistics Administration
- Understand how to use Approval Control Configuration

Purchasing Programs

- Stock Information provides information about the availability of parts at the home base and outstations
- Parts Consumption Forecast provides information about all parts that will be needed for current and future maintenance events.
- Advanced Reorder Proposal is used to ensure that adequate stock levels for consumable and rotatable parts are held in stores

Orders

- Find a detailed list of the most frequently used orders in AMOS
- Learn how to create a purchase order
- See how to create a quotation order and how to create a purchase order from a quotation
- Create a loan order and receive a loan component
- Learn how to create a sales list in Surplus Material and how to create a sales order from a pickslip
- See how to process a temporary repair order, add requirements and generate a repair order
- Watch the demo about Order Tracking and see how to send an order reminder

- Use Rotable Administration to see important data concerning rotatables
- Use Suspicious Parts for entering or displaying serial numbers that are no longer to be used, or have been reported stolen.
