This course provides a comprehensive overview of key Material Management processes, including material administration, order creation and processing, supplier and company price list setup, and approval configuration in AMOS.

- ✓ Create and manage different types of orders, especially purchase, repair, quotation, loan, exchange in advance, transfer and sales orders.
- ✓ Setup and control orders approval requests
- ✓ Follow-up the history of an order including the creation of reminders
- ✓ Create purchase orders based on the information given by the program Advanced Reorder Proposal
- ✓ Define the reorder details for consumables parts
